



## Regulations for the MYWEBSPORT monthly tournaments three cushion and five pins

Valid from November 2019

Each calendar month, 2 monthly tournaments, independent of each other, are played: 1 tournament in the discipline of three cushion, one in the discipline five pins. Both tournaments are played in the round robin tournament mode and in both tournaments there are €100.00 total prize money to win. All registered MWS users at all MWS locations worldwide are eligible to participate. A tournament registration is not required, a tournament entry is possible at any time. Each participant may play as many matches (remote and local) as he wishes – but at most 5 x per tournament against the same opponent. The entry fee is €2.00 per match and player. The billing of entry fees and prize money will take place at the end of the month via the MWS user accounts. 50% of the entry fees are paid aliquot to the participating locations.

Match mode (open end set system, long distance, challenge etc.) and match distance (number of winning sets, points etc.) are freely selectable, given only the discipline to be played and the following minimum requirements that apply to each match:

- Three cushion: The winner must have scored at least 15 points in total, or at least 20 innings must have been played in total.
- Five pins: The winner must have scored at least 75 points in total (including foul points received from the opponent), or at least 20 innings must have been played in total.

The players are responsible for the organization of the matches and the timely reporting of the results. Results must be reported to [sports@mywebsport.com](mailto:sports@mywebsport.com) or +43 664 970 13 00 with an evidence photo of the final MWS terminal scoreboard before the end of the month in which the match was played. For the ranking of the players in the monthly tournaments only the match points (MP) count, which the players received in the course of the tournament and which are awarded as follows:

- Win: 4.5 MP for remote matches, 3 MP for local matches
- Draw: 3 MP for remote matches, 2 MP for local matches
- Defeat: 1.5 MP for remote matches, 1 MP for local matches

The player with the most match points at the end of the monthly tournament wins the monthly tournament. If several players have the same number of match points, they will take the same placement ex aequo.

In addition to the main ranking, the monthly tournament in round robin mode, there are 2 additional rankings, which are calculated from the match results of the main ranking:

- High run ranking: From each match, the highest scored run of player A and the highest scored run of player B are added to the high run ranking. The player with the highest run scored at the end of the tournament wins this ranking. If the high runs of several players are the same, then for the ranking their second highest runs will be compared with each other and so on. If all runs of several players are the same, they will take the same placement ex aequo. For the discipline five pins, the highest possible run is 16 points because foul points are not counted in the run.
- Most matches ranking: The player who played the most matches at the end of the tournament wins this ranking. If several players have played the same number of matches, they will take the same placement ex aequo.

The total prize money of €100.00 per tournament will only be paid out and the entry fee of €2.00 per match and player will only have to be paid if at least 10 matches have been played in the relevant tournament. If there are fewer than 10 matches in the ranking, there will be no entry fee or prize money, but the results will be considered regular. The staggering of the total prize money per monthly tournament is as follows:

- Winner of the monthly tournament (main ranking): €40.00 for the player + €10.00 for the home location of the player
- Winner of the high run ranking (additional ranking): €20.00 for the player + €5.00 for the home location of the player
- Winner of the most matches ranking (additional ranking): €20.00 for the player + €5.00 for the home location of the player
- Total: €100.00

If several players win the same ranking, the prize money will be shared among the players and their home locations.

These regulations replace all previous regulations for our three cushion and five pins monthly tournaments and remain in effect until they are replaced by subsequent regulations. The regulations valid at the beginning of the tournament remain valid for the entire duration of the tournament. Regulatory changes can only take effect at the beginning of a new tournament – with the exception of organizational necessities – and are communicated accordingly.
