

# SET SYSTEM 'OPEN END'



## *Example THREE (3) POINTS OPEN END*

- Who first reaches 3 points can win the set if the opponent cannot at least equalize this score in the next inning.
  - The players play as long as they carom so that the run can always be finished.
  - Each player always has the possibility to catch up or outrun the other player in the following inning, no matter who started the set.
  - The set ends when one player cannot catch up or outrun the other player in the following inning.
- *Recommendation for short distances (bo3, bo5 ...): In a DECIDING SET both players play the opening shot in the first inning.*
