THREE CUSHION & 5-PINS & BIATHLON Invitation - from September 2022

Tournament series

The HOME TOUR will be held as a continuous tournament series from September 2022. There is no total ranking. Instead of a total ranking, the results are included in a ranking in the form of an ELO rating, similar to chess. The leaders are awarded prize money on certain dates (e.g. end of quarter, end of month, etc...).

The first HOME TOUR in the new format begins on 3rd of September 2022. The disciplines 3-Cushion and 5-Pins will start at the same time. At a later date Biathlon will also be played.

The duration of the tournaments depends on the number of participants. The tournament always begins on a Saturday and ends on a Friday. The dates of the games are arranged by the participants themselves.

Group stage	3 weeks or longer
KO stage	1 week or longer

If necessary (time delay), the tournament management can set fixed dates for matches. The matches in question must then be played by the fixed date, or at the latest on the fixed date. The fixed dates are set for the last tournament week, depending on the number of matches and according to the following scheme:

(1st option) FR from 17:00, (2nd option) TH+FR from 17:00, (3rd option) WE-FR from 17:00, (4th option) TU-FR from 17:00, (5th option) MO-FR from 17:00.

As soon as a tournament is over (always Friday) the next tournament starts on the following Saturday. It is possible for several players to participate at one location.

Mode

Up to 12 participants will be played in round robin mode. From 13 participants in groups, then in KO system.

13 to 20 participants: 2 groups | 21 to 30 P: 3 groups | 31 to 40 P: 4 groups | etc.

Registration deadline

Always on the Sunday before the start of the tournament.

Eligibility, locations, minimum number of participants

All players with access to a MWS system. All MWS locations. Minimum 4 participants per tournament.

Qualifying tournaments

If scheduling becomes problematic due to a high number of participants at a location, qualifying tournaments are necessary.

Registration for the tournament, organization of game dates, entry of game dates, entry of results

Online and in self-administration on the MWS website under <https://www.mywebsport.com/user> (point "Sports administration" in the main menu).

Entry of the result by the winner of the match. All match dates must be entered in the sports administration in advance. All matches must be streamed live (function button on the MWS terminal).

Distances

Three Cushion: 3 Points open end best of 5(7), tie break in decider
5-Pins: 100 (120) Pts or 50 (60) Pts (set system)

Entry fee

35 Euros per tournament and player.

Prize money

The amount of the prize money depends on the number of participants.

If there are two third places, the prize money is shared.

(10% of the prize money goes to the home location of the winners.)

Total payout

100% of the total entry fee will be distributed to the participants. The difference between the total entry fee and the prize money of each individual tournament is used for the ELO-bonuses (80%) and for the MWA youth promotion (20%).

If additional sponsorship is gained for a tournament, then this will be divided like the guidelines of digital banner advertising and the prize money will be increased accordingly.

Unless otherwise stated, the information applies to all disciplines. The invitation is valid until a new invitation replaces it. The participants must allow the public streaming of their matches (terminal function) and agree to the publication of their person in image, streaming, text and sound.
